AVAILABLE POSITIONS

RESIDENT ASSISTANT

Position Type: Student (Over 18)

Resident Assistants serve as peer leaders for their fellow students in the Summer Resident Program. While their primary responsibility is the safety and well-being of the student body, their central focus is crafting an engaging and welcoming environment which considers and respects the needs of a diverse student population many of whom may be away from home for the first time.

Responsibilities and Duties

- Create and maintain a safe, secure and nurturing residential environment for all students.
- Work in conjunction with the Resident Housing Supervisor and Student Services Manager to create rules and guidelines for Summer Intensive students.
- Adhere to all Cincinnati Ballet and residence hall policies and procedures.
- Establish a common understanding of Cincinnati Ballet/residence hall policies: conduct an orientation session for all resident students; review all resident regulations and schedules; familiarize students with campus facilities.
- Enforce disciplinary action as necessary, determined by Cincinnati Ballet and residence hall behavioral guidelines and at the direction of the Resident Housing Supervisor.
- Accompany students to all meals/events/activities during scheduled work time. No student under the age of 18 years old may remain unsupervised at any time.
- Establish a daily routine for the students in consultation with the Student Services Manager and Resident Housing Supervisor. Institute engaging, informal activities for the students during evening hours. Be reasonably accommodating to students' activity requests, while exercising mature judgment.
- Communicate all problems that arise and cannot be handled by the Resident Assistant to the Resident Housing Supervisor and/or Student Services Manager in a timely manner.

Qualifications and Requirements

- Eligibility is contingent upon audition and acceptance to the Summer Intensive program
- Flexibility, positive attitude and superior customer service
- Exceptional moral character and an ability to lead by example
- Prior experience in customer care
- Strong commitment to the protection and safety of minors
- Attention to detail, highly responsible, strong work ethic and excellent organizational skills
- Ability to enforce disciplinary action
- Candidate should be available for all six weeks of program and be engaged as a student in the program (program tuition is the responsibility of the student)
- Must be 18 years of age or older by program start date

- Candidate will be subject to a criminal background and motor vehicle check

WEEKEND CHAPERONE

Position Type: Adult

Responsibilities and Duties

- Chaperone students on weekend outings and ensure their safety and well-being from pick up through drop off at the residence hall
- Establish ground rules for weekend trips and designate group sizes and expectations
- Account for and distribute event tickets to students
- Account for and distribute per diem for student lunches, if outings occur during lunch hours
- Act as first responder for all student emergencies and get in touch with student emergency contacts and Student Services Manager in the event of an incident

Qualifications and Requirements

- Flexibility, positive attitude and superior customer service
- Prior experience in customer care and student supervision
- Strong commitment to the protection and safety of minors
- Attention to detail, highly responsible, strong work ethic and excellent organizational skills
- Ability to enforce disciplinary action as necessary
- Candidate will be subject to a criminal background, motor vehicle, and credit check
- Potential dates of service: June 26, 27 and July 3, 4, 10, 11, 17, 18, 24 and 25

Rate: \$12/hour

Note: Parent must provide own overnight accommodations, if needed. Candidate need not be available for all chaperone dates. Please indicate dates of availability in your application and cover letter.
