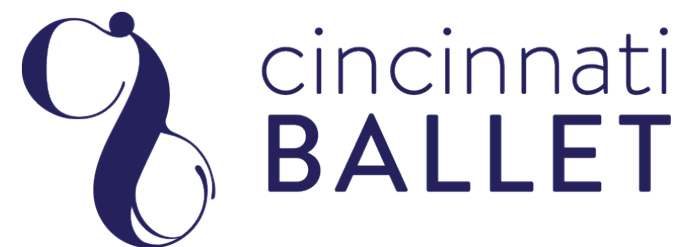




Visiting Cincinnati Ballet

I will put on my mask.

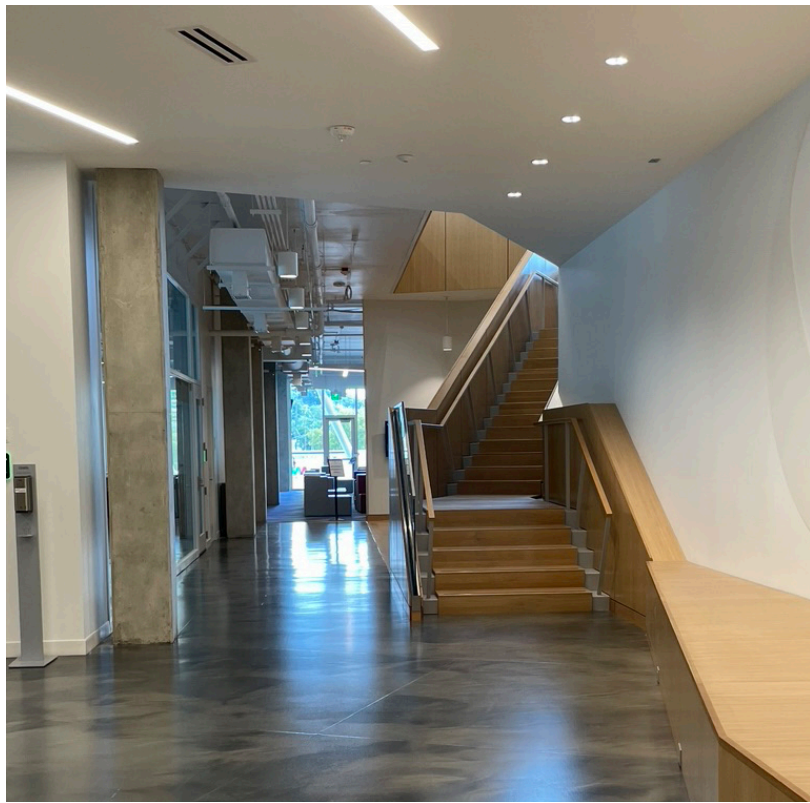
I will wear my mask the entire

I will get in the elevator and press number 1.



When the elevator opens on the 1st floor, I will see a long hallway.
My studio is at the end of this hallway.

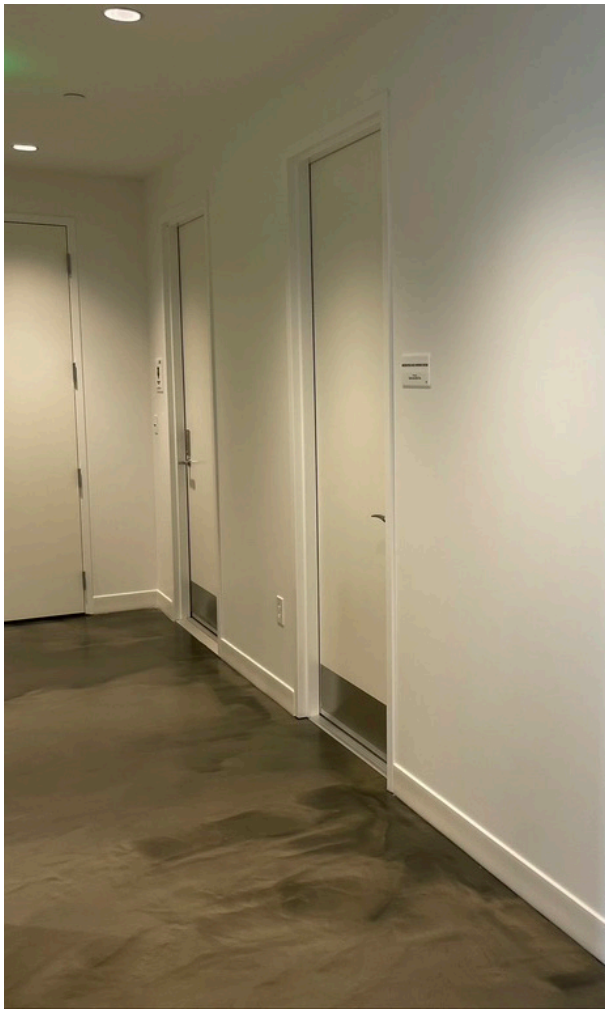
Before I go down the hallway, to my right there is a waiting area with

The quiet meditation and nursing room is near the waiting area.

This is where I can go if I need a break.
This is a very quiet space.



I will go down the hallway towards the big staircase to get to the Otto M. Budig Community Studio.

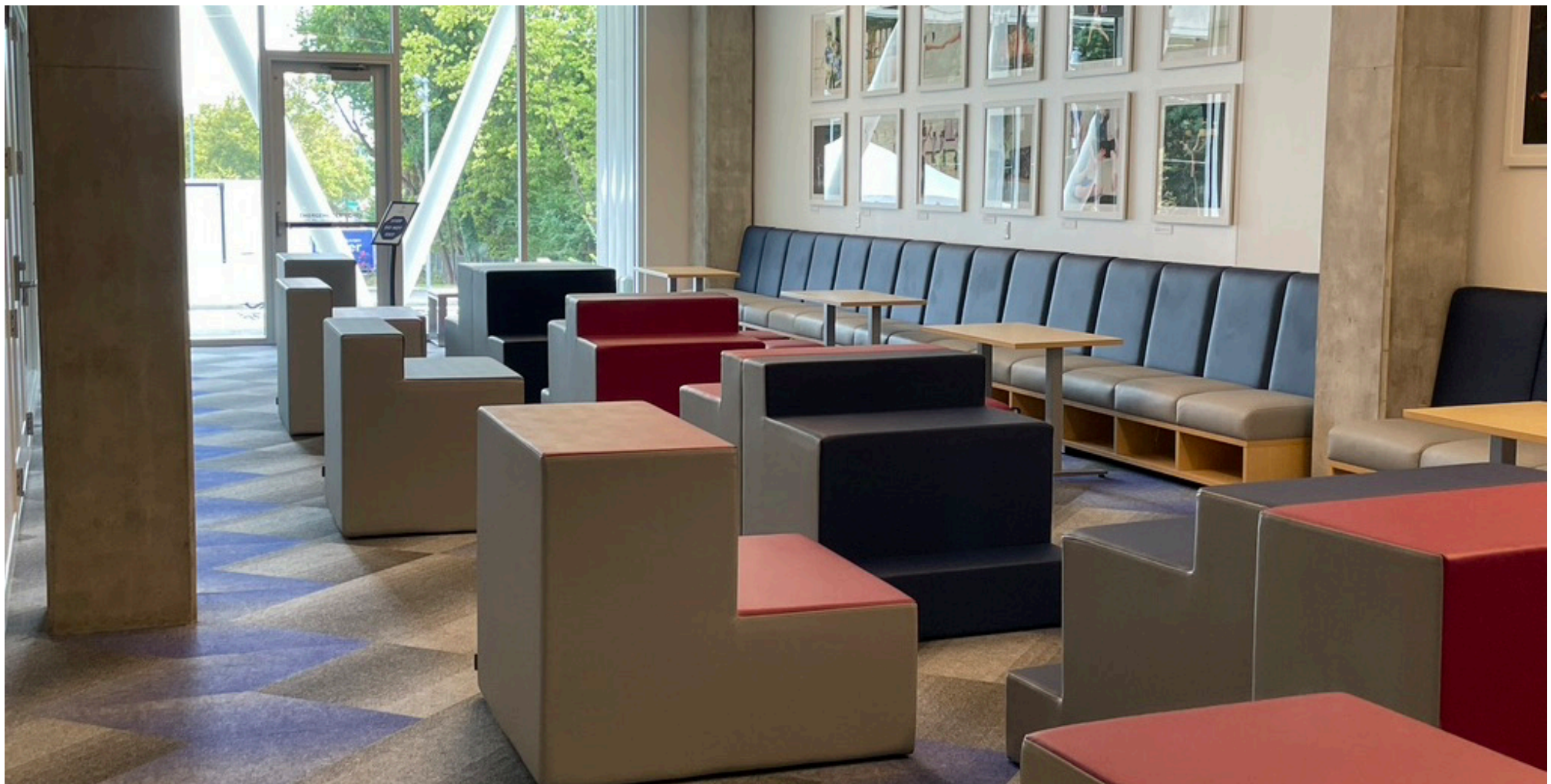


Past the big staircase in the hallway, there is an accessible restroom everyone can use.



At the end of the hallway, there are changing booths.
This is where I can change into my dance clothes.

There is a water fountain; this is where I can fill up my water bottle.



Outside of the Otto M. Budig Community Studio, there is a large waiting room.

This is where I will wait until it is time for my class.
My family can wait here too.



My classes take place in the Otto M. Budig Community Studio.
I am not allowed to bring in any food or drinks, except water.
I am allowed to bring in my water bottle.

This room has overhead lifts.



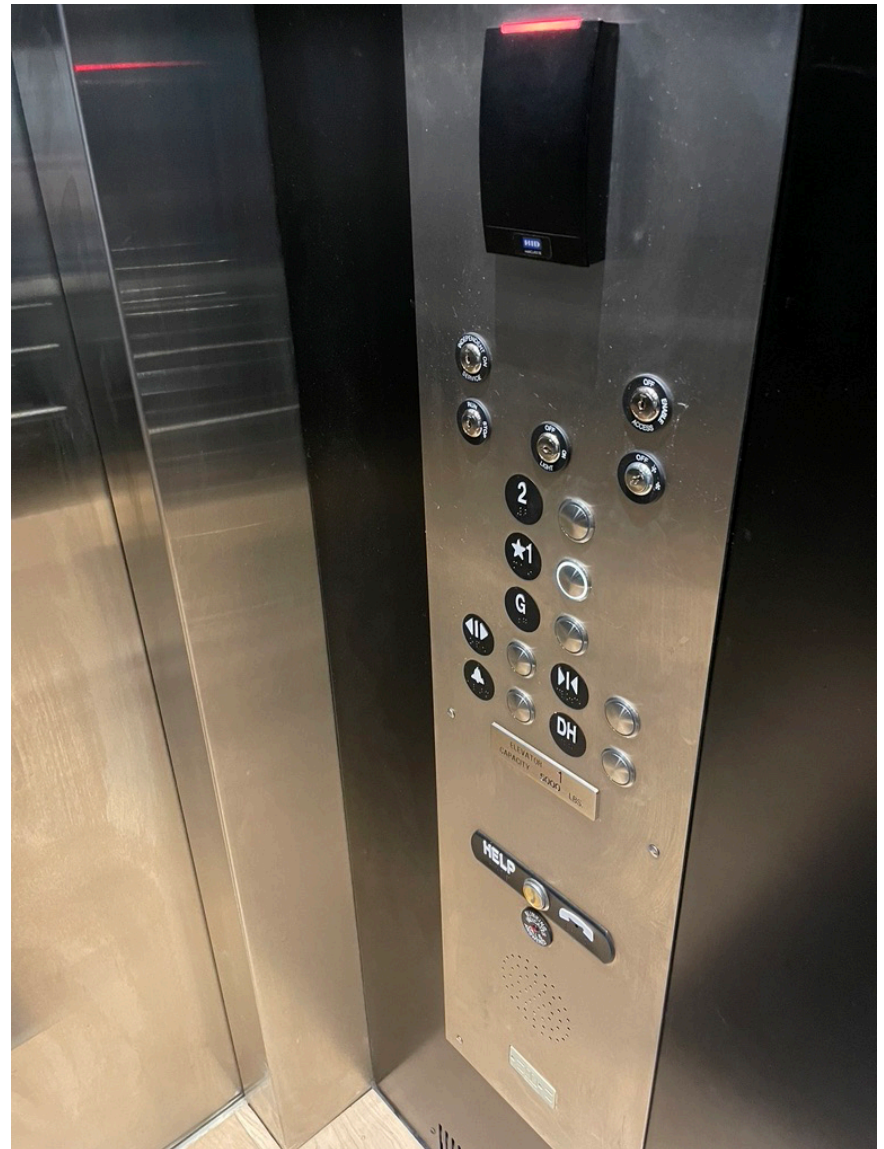
When I am in class, if I need a break, there is a quiet corner.
